#### **Other important information:**

- Athletes must present to the classification 30 minutes before the allocated time on the classification schedule.
- Athletes must bring a passport along with their accreditation.
- Athletes must be accompanied by one support person proficient in English.
- Athletes should be appropriately dressed in sports clothes. We recommend wearing shorts for the classification evaluation.
- Must bring all sports equipment and competition clothing including shoes to be used in competition (for technical assessment).

#### **Physical Impairment specific:**

Athletes using throwing frames/racing wheelchairs should do the technical assessment while using their own equipment. The teams are responsible for making arrangements through the storages for transportation of the equipment from Storage 1 to Storage 2. This should be done by 6 PM the day before the moves needs to be done using the form at the storages as per the Team Information Session.

**Intellectual Impairment specific:** Must bring visual correction aids to classification if needed.

**Visual Impairment specific:** Must bring the visual correction aids used in training and competition to classification.
