		related Technical Documents prior to the determination of an Adverse Analytical Finding.
ADRV	Anti-Doping Rule Violation	An AAF or ATF, or any other investigation that is not supported by a TUE or where no apparent departure of the applicable International Standards is derived.



IPC Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) Management in 2012

In total, IPC approved 15 TUEs for athletes that either belong to the IPC Registered Testing Pool or required emergency TUE management at the *London 2012 Paralympic Games.

Breakdown by sport: IPC Athletics – 1; IPC Powerlifting – 2; IPC Swimming – 3; IBSA Judo – 1*; IBSA – Football-5-a-side – 1*; WOVD Sitting Volleyball – 1*; Para-Cycling – 4*; Para-Equestrian – 1*; Wheelchair Fencing – 1*.
