To: World Shooting Para Sport

My primary intents in the World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) would be to promote inclusion in shooting sport and to make the shooting sport world more united.

Since year 2020 I have been a part of the Finnish Paralympic visual impaired shooting team and learnt that specific shooting discipline besides the Finnish Shooting Sport Federation physical impaired shooting team disciplines in rifle, pistol and shotgun. Furthermore, I have visited f.ex a Polish training camp to expand my knowledge of para-shooting in other countries. I think I have a good understanding about inclusion challenges in different shooting sport disciplines.

During my years in the European Shooting Confederation (ESC) and International Military Sport Council (CISM) I have been involved in all shooting sports – rifle, pistol, shotgun and running target – both in an organisational level but also in practise not to forgot to mention many relationships with individual shooting officials around the world. One example of organisational work was incorporating the shotgun shooting into the military shooting sport and widen the CISM shooting to many new countries. In my opinion my understanding about shooting sport is sufficient to promote that all shooting sport should be under one unified international body. Naturally, activities for able and impaired body athletes, as well as discipline and age groups can be organised separately.

Years 1999 – 2018 I was a technical delegate of the Nordic Military Shooting (Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Finland) and years 2009 – 2018 I was a member (vice president) in the Shooting Committee of the International Military Sport Council (CISM) until my retirement of my 30-year-long military career.
