In 2018 I published an autobiography titled "The only incurable thing is the desire to live", Temas de Hoy editorial (second edition), where I explain how I recovered physically and psychologically from that injury.

In 2022 I received the Gold Medal of the Royal Order of Sports Merit. I am currently dedicated to deliver awareness sessions to companies through the Adecco Foundation, and I am the image of several brands and advertising spots such as Barbie (2019), Adidas (2021-present), Pantane (2023), Visa (2023-present) or Toyota (2023-present).

Additionally, this year I am preparing to compete in my second Paralympic Games, Paris 2024.

Today, I can proudly say that I am a telecommunications engineer and a young secondary school teacher.

Sports have always gone hand in hand in my case. I've always practiced individual sports and as a 13-year-old teenager I discovered athletics. I began to stand out soon in both speed and jumps events and little by little I professionalized my activity and my training until in 2014 I managed to debut in my first international championship.
